

The office of the Board of Control is located on the campus of the Florida State University because the State has not furnished to this agency adequate quarters of its own. The members of the staff of the Board would, of course, prefer to have their own building, and the University would wisely use the space now occupied by the Board. The relationship between the Board staff and the University have always been cordial and friendly.

The presence of the Board offices on the campus, however, has raised questions which should be clarified for the faculty.

There are no direct relations between members of the faculty and the staff of the Board of Control. Various faculty members are called upon from time to time to serve on inter-university committees which report to the Board, made up of the presidents of the various institutions along with the Director of the Board of Control, and are sent on officially to the Board of Control.

I shall consider it a breach of good faith on the part of the University community to have any direct relationships with the Board of Control except as those persons are requested to do so by Mr. Shaw, Mr. Davis, or myself.
