Well pit # 89 yield clayey marl  
plug, as did 90, 91, along  
edge of pond E. Clay is unusual  
in this area as surface deposit, although  
not sure re: subsurface (no <sup>remembered</sup> mention  
in "soils of Beward"). Report via  
G+D from Spachman suggested  
Clay in last years (North end pond  
only) "Greeny peat" ~ <sup>thought</sup> was  
his in clay! This marl may be re in  
contemporary w/ the greeny peat +  
source of clay in that deposit. <sup>The</sup> Greeny  
peat occurred at <sup>or</sup> under the bone / rubber peat.
