- In LOT 236 - NW quad 200+cm found a mandible, two verts and a phalange - bone still pedestaled in SW quad - may have a new Burial LOT soon.

In LOT 58 only a vertebra so far - still pedestaled. - The mandible in LOT 236 is in a drying crack and will be pulled as soon as possible rather than leaving it in situ as we expose more of the possible block. The mandible and other bones in NW quad of 236 is at a lower elevation than most the bone in B.L. 58. This is strange in that the slope of the pond would suggest that ~~the bone~~ the bone in 236 should be higher than that in B.L. 58.

- LETS Dig at least 20cm + into the fiber before it is completely stilt!
