By Letter

If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior, are already a member of a Baptist church and wish to join our church, we will request a "letter" of transfer from your present church.

By Statement

If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior, and are a member of a church other than a Baptist church, you may become a member of our church by your "statement" of faith in Christ. Our church requires baptism as a believer by immersion before becoming a member.

By Associate Membership

If you are a temporary resident of this area (a college student, for example) you may keep your membership in your home church while you are under the care of our church.
