

Dalton Ga May 5th 1864

Dear Wife,

I arrived here on Tuesday night at 1 oclock and found everything much better than I had expected. The Colonel told me that he did not blame me for staying at home as long as I did. He said that he knew that I was not able for duty and said that I would have to go before the Medical Board and be placed on the retired list. He says that there is no doubt that what I will be placed on the retired list and advises me to do that instead of resigning. He says that I have been disabled in the service of the Government and that it is the duty of the government to support me--Everybody seemed glad to see me and I have heard but one opinion about my case and that is that I am not fit for service. I have not seen nor heard anything of Arms ball and chain nor heard anything of Archys disgrace. A fight is expected here soon. Give my love to the old men to Sally Martha and Lizzie & accept the same for yourself and Hugh
