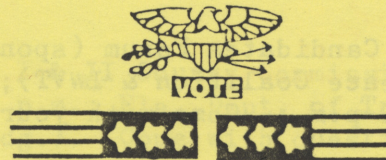
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

VOTER SERVICE

It started with registering 306 voters on the 4th of July at Tom Brown Park, and continued with registering 232 voters at Governor's Mall the last weekend in July. The following weekend, which is the first weekend in August, will be the last registration drive at the Governor's Square Mall before closing of the books for voting in the primaries. On Friday, Aug. 15, there will be a "Meet the Candidates Night" at Governor's Square with local, state and national candidates invited to mingle with shoppers from 4:30 to 8:30 p.m.
